Dear parents or guardians,

This year, students will get their own student accounts on [Upskill Me](#) to record their achievements, skills and interests. Your child's school will also use Upskill Me to track careers provision and enrichment programmes. It's an effective way for the school to see how students are building their skills and to provide opportunities to access work experience, events and skill building courses and you can also see what your child is doing to develop their skills by logging into their account using their details.

With their student account, your child will share what skills they've developed through logging activities, writing reflection statements, and adding evidence such as photos and certificates on their own digital portfolio. They can record any awards they've won, work experience they have gained, or projects they're proud of - both in and out of school. So that when they're applying for jobs and further education, they've got everything they need. It's all in one place.

This portfolio can only be seen by your child, you, and the school. When your child turns 16 they will have the opportunity to publish their student profile to universities and employers when applying for opportunities to strengthen their application. Your child will be able to view their progress and discover new opportunities.
